The Brief

H.H. Smith were selected to construct a new state of the art community building including a sports hall, office space and associated changing rooms. External works included a new artificial sports area with 2 large 3rd generation football pitches, and car parking facilities.

Key Points

The formation of the football pitches required the re-leveling and terracing of the existing playing area, and involved moving some 3,500 cubic metres of earth. The whole area was drained into a 12m x 12m x 4m soak-away.

Challenges

H.H. Smith were required to work very closely with the Environmental Department of Bury Council as many of the existing trees on the site are protected by TPO's (tree preservation orders).
